



CHATEAU FAURIE DE SOUCHARD

GRAND CRU CLASSÉ DE SAINT-EMILION



THE ESTATE

Area: 12 Ha (28.4 acres)

Situation: On the northern hill of Saint-Emilion

Soil: Clayey slopes, sandy clay at the foot of the slopes

Grape varieties: 70 % Merlot, 25 % Cabernet Franc, 5 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Average age of the vines: 30 years

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

Pruning: double guyot, debudding

Leaf removal: by hand, on both sides of rows

Green harvesting: if necessary

WINEMAKING PROCESS & AGEING

Winemaking: traditional, in concrete vats and oak vats, with temperature control

Ageing: 75% new barrels, 25% one-year-old barrels

Ageing period: 14 to 16 months; depending plots

PRODUCTION IN 2015

Surface area harvested: 12 Ha (29.65 acres)

Grape varieties: Merlot 70%, Cabernet Franc 25%, Cabernet Sauvignon 5%

Harvesting: from 1st to 15 October

Yield: 37 HL/Ha

Production:

- Château Faurie de Soucard: 39,500 bottles (estimate)
