



CHATEAU FAURIE DE SOUCHARD



THE VINEYARD

Location : On the northern hill of Saint-Emilion

Area : 12 hectares (28.4 acres) in a single plot, including 10,2 hectares (24.14 acres) in production.

Soil types: Clayey slopes, sandy clay at the foot of the slopes

Grape varieties : 70 % Merlot, 25 % Cabernet-Franc, 5 % Cabernet-Sauvignon

Average age of the wines: 30 years

PRODUCTION IN 2013

Surface area harvested : 9,5 Ha

Grape varieties : Merlot 63%, Cabernet-Franc 31%, Cabernet sauvignon 6%

Harvesting : 2nd, 12th, 16th of October

WINEMAKING PROCESS & AGEING

Winemaking : New barrels: 50%, 1 wine barrels 50%.

Ageing period: 12 to 16 months; depending plots

PRODUCTION / COMMERCIALISATION

Yield 2013: 20 HL/Ha

Château Faurie de Soucard: 16,000 bottles (estimate)

Pavillon de Soucard: 12,000 bottles (estimate)
